## APPLICATION

$\neg$ Rigid insulation fixing with premounted pin.

## DESCRIPTION

$\neg$ Polyethylen High density.
$\neg \mathrm{Cl}-6$ :

- The pin head (for $\mathrm{Cl}-6$ ) is mould in thermoplasticelastomer to improve the corrosion resistance
- A protection cap to allow a good waterproofness and to reduce thermic transmission

## DISTANCE RULES

Between 2 fixings: minimum distance of 90 mm
Distance from edge: minimum distance of 100 mm

## ANCHOR DEPTH



It must be between 25 and 31 mm to ensure the recommended load given above.

## APPLICATION LIMIT

The mean compressive strength of the concrete must be between C20/25 and C40/50.

## RECOMMENDED LOAD

## $\neg$ TENSILE

The recommended load $(\mathrm{kN})$ are calculated from the mean ultimate load and a safety factor higher than 4.

## SHEAR

The recommended pull-through (kN) are calculated from the failure load and a safety factor equal to 3 .
